
Re: PSE&G/Vegetation Management

Dear Mr. Richter:

On behalf of Bridgewater Township, I am, again, requesting that PSE&G delay vegetation management in Bridgewater. As I understand it, PSE&G intends to commence management this month.

It has come to my attention that the BPU has decided to postpone action on the proposed vegetation management regulations. The BPU action on the regulations had been scheduled to take place on Friday, February 1, 2008. I will not reiterate, here, the positions and content of correspondence Mayor Patricia Flannery has recently sent to you and the BPU, and the Mayor's request for a delay in the management program. Suffice it to say that until the BPU has had the opportunity to consider the proposed regulations, as well as the comments and position papers submitted by Bridgewater Township regarding those regulations, it would appear vegetation management, pursuant to regulations not yet adopted, would be both anomalous and irregular.
