## Zone 1 / Within 30 feet of all structures or to the property line::

#### ✓ Pass

ITEM: A. All branches within 10 feet of any chimney or stovepipe outlet have been removed

#### ✓ Pass

ITEM: B. Leaves, needles or other vegetation on roofs, gutters, decks, porches, stairways, etc. have been removed

#### ✓ Pass

**ITEM:** C. All dead and dying trees, branches and shrubs, or other plants adjacent to or overhanging buildings have been removed

ITEM: D. All dead and dying grass, plants, shrubs, trees, branches, leaves, weeds and needles are removed

#### **REMARK:**

Remove dead trees

Remove any dead plants or dead parts of plants within 30 feet of structures on your property.

Limb dead branches out of trees to 15 feet off ground.

Remove all needles, leaves, pinecones and dead branches from ground within 30 feet of structure, under decks, and inside plants near home.

Remove all pinecones and dead branches from ground on entire property.

You can keep up to 3 inches depth of pine needle duff (decomposed black pine needles) or chip on the ground outside of the 5-foot zone around home to prevent erosion and dust.

5' around entire structure including decks must be free of all combustible materials (mulch, pine needles, chip, etc)

ITEM: E. Live flammable ground cover and shrubs have been removed or separated - see link:

**ITEM:** F. Flammable vegetation and items that could catch fire which are adjacent to, or below, combustible decks, balconies, and stairs have been removed

Remove or completely cover wood piles and lumber with ember resistant tarps, within 30 feet of any structure

**ITEM:** M. Outbuildings and Liquid Propane Gas (LPG) storage tanks have 10 feet of clearance to bare mineral soil and no flammable vegetation for an additional 10 feet around their exterior

**ITEM:** O. Chimney or stovepipe openings are equipped with a metal screen having openings between 3/8 inch and 1/2 inch
